- I. Officers' Reports:
 - a. President – Courtnie: no report

 - c. Treasurer – Linda: All is good with the finances.

- II. Director, Coordinator, Committee Reports:

- III. Show Chair Reports:

 - c. Fall Frolic: Lisa reported that she had trouble with Troy's Hay Hauling and the straw. We may not be using that company next year due to his attitude.

- III. Old Business:
 - a. 2015 Convention: Elaine reported that she has posters up for people to view and sign up for jobs.
 - b. Entry forms are complete and class sheets have been revised to reflect the need for smaller classes especially in the yearling wether and doe classes. Wethers under a year are every 3 months and does under a year are every two months.
 - c. We will need sponsorship for all of the classes. Linda C. asked about making sponsorship payments through Pay Pal. Elaine is sponsorship Coordinator and felt that there could be confusion on classes sponsored if we use Pay Pal.
 - d. The Jr. Show will stay pretty much the same. There was a suggestion to break down the showmanship classes. There was some discussion as to whether or not to have a buck show as part of the Jr. Show. It was decided that there aren't enough bucks owned by the juniors.

- e. The menu for the banquet will be Lasagna catered by Justin Josephson. Pizza for the kids.
- f. Ribbons have yet to be decided. Normal size rosettes run \$ 1.60 - \$ 1:90. Double rosettes run \$ 2.20 - \$ 2.60. JT suggested that we have nicer ribbons for the National Champion class. Sponsorship will cover that class awards because it's a different category than the general classes. We will talk more about ribbons at the next show.
