- Local and State Rules Govern this Competition.
- Open to 4-H, FFA, and Independent Junior exhibitors 8 years through 19
  years of age from California. Age as of January 1, 2017, except for special
  juniors who must be 5 years old as of June 30, 2017.
- 3. All animals must be N.P.G.A. registered. Copies of registration papers may be sent with entry, or they may be checked the morning of the show.
- 4. Health Check: Only healthy animals may be entered. Any animals having runny noses and/or eyes or other obvious signs of illness will be requested to leave. The decision made by the show committee is final and entry fees will not be refunded.
- 5. Exhibitors must be bonafide owner of all entries 60 days prior to the show.
- 6. Classes may be combined, if there are less than three entries per class.
- The <u>AMERICAN SYSTEM OF JUDGING</u> will be used in all classes.
- 8. 4-H and FFA members must wear official uniforms in the ring for both showmanship and breed classes. Independent juniors must wear ankle length white pants and a white blouse or shirt.
- 9. Bedding, (straw), will be provided by Fair.
- 10. Exhibitors must clean their stalls before departure.
- 11. Horned Pygmy Goats are allowed in the show.
