Showmanship: There will be no showmanship for the Friday show. Classes will be offered on Saturday and Sunday. There will be NO entry fee. ****Youth should stay in the same showmanship class throughout the year based on their age as of January 1, 2021****

Prospect Wethers: \$2.50 per goat, per class, per day entered.

Pre-Entry Fee: \$8.00 for SPPGA members, \$10.00 for non-SPPGA members per goat, per class, per day entered (Entries postmarked June 8, 2021 and before).

Late Entry Fee: Late fees have been waived for this show.

Pens: Limited pens will be available on a first come, first served basis at \$8.00 per pen for the show. Please let Rylee or Diane know immediately if you will need pens. Exhibitors may also bring their own pens to set up in the arena or show out of their trailers at no cost. The show will be held in a fully enclosed indoor building with concrete floor. Bedding will be provided for those who purchase pens. If you are bringing your own pens, you will need to bring your own bedding or contact show chairs to arrange for shavings. **All bedding must be cleaned up prior to exhibitors leaving.** We will have wheelbarrows, rakes, shovels, manure forks, etc., for you to use.

Checks Payable To: SPPGA – **SPPGA has a no refund policy on entry fees.**
Entries may also be e-mailed with payment made by PayPal. See the SPPGA website’s PayPal tab for payment.

Arrival Time: Friday, June 18th after 11:00 am PLEASE. If you need to arrive earlier, please let Rylee or Diane know.

Parking: Parking will be on the west side of the Sheep Barn. There will be a livestock jackpot show occurring on Saturday and we have been given this specific area for our use exclusively. The RV hookups are directly across from the parking area in very close proximity to the show arena. Parking is right next to the show arena so there will be easy access for those showing out of there trailers. **Please make sure you park only in the area assigned to our show.**

- Camping:** There is an RV hookup fee of \$25.00 for the weekend. Upon arrival at the show barn, contact Rylee or Diane and they can get you to the office to pay for your space. Only water and electricity are available. There are no sewer connections.
- Judging Order:** Friday, 5:00 pm: Show 1 does and bucks. **No Showmanship for Show 1.**
Saturday, 9:00 am: Show 1 wethers; Show 2 showmanship, wethers, does, bucks; Show 3 bucks.
Sunday, 9:00 am: Show 3 showmanship, wethers, does.
- NPGA Rules:** NPGA requires that all animals 6 months of age or older must have a legible tattoo and/or microchip prior to being shown. Exhibitors shall not show any doe or buck in an NPGA sanctioned show with the herd name of the judge who is judging the show. This rule does not apply to wethers. Although the show chair, secretary or designee will check the registration papers prior to the goat being shown to ensure that each goat has been entered in the correct age class and division, it is the ultimate responsibility of the exhibitor that the exhibitor's goat(s) is/are entered and shown in the correct class and division.
- Registration Papers:** Only animals with original registration papers or transfer of ownership (less than 90 days old) and registration papers will be allowed to show (with the exception of wethers).
- Bring Healthy Animals:** Only healthy animals are allowed on the premises. Animals having runny nose or eyes, coughs or obvious signs of illness will be requested to leave the grounds unless accompanied by a signed veterinarian statement that the animal is healthy. The decision of the show committee is final and entry fees will not be refunded.
- Prospect Wether Class:** The purpose of the class is for exhibitors to have the chance to show bucklings that are obviously going to be wethers, but have chosen not to castrate them at an early age. The class will be the first wether class judged, however these animals will not compete for the Best Wether and Reserve Best Wether. This class is limited to animals between the ages of 0 to 5 months that have not yet been castrated. **Please note the cost to enter this class has been reduced to \$2.50.**
- Awards:** Class strip ribbons will be offered for first through fifth places in each class. During wethers, does and bucks, tickets to first through fifth places will be given in each class for a drawing to be held at the end of each show and cash prizes will be given. NPGA rosette ribbons will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion in each division and also to the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion in the registered doe and buck divisions. Certificates will be awarded to Premier Breeder and Exhibitor each day.
- Raffle & Auction:** There will be a raffle after the show on Saturday, with all proceeds going to SPPGA. Tickets will be on sale all day Saturday. An auction will be held after lunch on Saturday. Any raffle and auction donations will be *greatly* appreciated. Please tape your name or business card to your donations so we know who to thank!
- Food:** The show is not near any food venues. Food will be available on site. Exhibitors will be notified of food choices prior to the event. The Tulelake FFA will also be hosting a food booth on Saturday during the livestock jackpot show.
- Dogs:** Dogs are allowed on the premises only if they are on a leash at all times and provided the owner cleans up after them. **Please keep dogs away from the show ring.**

Directions to Facility:

From the South via US 97:

From the agricultural inspection station in Dorris, California, travel approximately 4 miles and turn right on Stateline Road. Go approximately 19 miles on Highway 161 (Stateline Road) to an intersection with Highway 39. Turn right (south) and proceed 3.6 miles. Turn right on Main Street. Follow Main Street for 0.7 miles and turn right on G Street (the high school will be to the left at the turn). The main entrance of the fairgrounds is at this corner. Continue west past the main entrance and past the G Street entrance to the RV entrance (road dead ends so must turn either left or right). Turn left (south) into the RV area. There will be signs at the RV entrance and the parking area indicating where to go for the pygmy goat show.

Note: Google Maps shows traveling past Hwy 161 (Stateline Road) on 97 to Township Road and then cutting back to Hwy 161, adding 3 or 4 miles to the journey. We can find no reason (i.e., road construction, etc.) for this but if you see this is the case, simply continue to Township Road, turn right and proceed using your GPS.

Second note: This is a high activity area for bald eagles. Keep an "eagle eye" out for these majestic creatures. In a normal year, you would most assuredly see them but in this drought year, the Lower Klamath National Wildlife Refuge is completely dry so the eagles may be further east towards Tulelake and out of sight. Worth looking for though!

From the North via US 97:

As you approach Klamath Falls, there will be a Pilot Travel Center on the left side of the road. From the Pilot Travel Center, stay slight right to stay on US 97. Go 4.3 miles and take the OR-66/OR-140 exit. Turn left onto OR-140/OR-66E. Go 6.0 miles and turn right on Hwy 39 S. Go approximately 17 miles and enter California. Proceed 3.6 miles. Turn right on Main Street. Follow Main Street for 0.7 miles and turn right on G Street (the high school will be to the left prior to turning). The main entrance of the fairgrounds is at this corner. Continue west past the main entrance and past the G Street entrance to the RV entrance (road dead ends so must turn either left or right). Turn left (south) into the RV area and proceed south. There will be signs at the RV entrance and the parking area indicating where to go for the pygmy goat show.
