



SPPGA Meeting Minutes
April 17, 2021
Susanville, CA

Meeting called to order at 1:33pm by President Courtnie Braziel

- I. Officers Reports:
 - A. President Courtnie had nothing to report.
 - B. Vice President J.T. Struthers had nothing to report.
 - C. Treasure Katie Ellebrecht reported that our accounts are in good shape but all shows are in the red at this time.
 - D. Courtnie reported that the minutes were sent out. Motion made to approve by Diane Keith second by Andrea Pursely MSC.
- II. Directors :
 - A. Directors Report: No director was present, so no report
 - B. Judges Selection: Tammi Josephson reported that she went through the entire list and backup list to fill the shows with judges.
 - C. Webmaster: Courtnie reported for Monica that the addition of Pay Pal to the website has been very successful. Also, the show schedule is up to date with information provided by the show chairs. - D. State Fair: Tammi reported that the people in charge still don't know if it will happen. If it does, it won't be in July.
- E. Redwood Rumble: Katie reported that all is going well. There will not be COVID restrictions in place. Judges will be April Seiler and Bryson Staley.
- F. High Sierra Madness: J.T. reported that the judges will be Jennifer Lozoya, Skyler Shamp and Karen Crawford. The show will begin Friday at 5:00pm and the fair committee is very happy to have us.
- G. Goat-tober-fest: Tammy reported that the Arnez family is very excited that we are returning. They may be doing a barbeque. Judges will be the Braggs.
- H. Fall Frolic: Courtnie reported the judges will be Paula Arnold and Randy Arnold.

IV. Old Business:

V. New Business:

- A. Reinstate "show money": J.T. Suggested that we bring back the "Show money" for the show chairs to dole out to those who help at the shows as a thank you. It can be used for entries etc. Gina suggested we could give it also to new exhibitors as an incentive to come to another show. Katie disagreed that newbies need it. J.T. explained it was for the weekend. Katie suggested \$50.00 an event to be used. - B. Raffle Basket for Convention: Katie suggested the SPPGA should donate a raffle basket to Convention each year in memory of Michelle Fonda. She suggests \$250.00 - \$500.00. Nick suggested the club do \$250.00 and the members donate the remainder. Maybe someone can chair it each year by picking a theme and

monitoring the items. A member can be picked at the January meeting.
